



DISTRICT REPRESENTATIVE DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

District representatives are voting members of the Blount County Democratic Party Executive Committee. District representatives are expected to represent Democrats within their district and participate in governing the Blount County Democratic Party (BCDP). Specific duties and responsibilities include, but are not limited to, the following:

1. Attend and participate in the regular and special meetings of the Executive Committee
2. Prepare in advance of meetings by reading or otherwise becoming familiar with items and issues that will come before the Executive Committee
3. Support and participate in BCDP committees, events and functions
4. Represent the BCDP in a way that reflects positively on the party and its values.
5. Bring issues that may arise in your district to the Executive Committee and otherwise represent Democrats in your district
6. Build support for the party and Democratic values in your district
7. Foster communication among democrats within your district and with the County party
8. Help in keeping Democratic voter and supporter lists accurate and current
9. Coordinate with other district representatives and alternates in your district
10. Actively support and participate in GET OUT THE VOTE (G-O-T-V) activities to support Democratic candidates at all levels.
